(Be: Was, Were)

The simple Past Tense is used principally to describe events in the past

1/Be: Was /Were in the positive ,negative and interrogative form:

Positive	Negative	Short Form	Interrogative
		Negative	Form
I was	I was not	I wasn't	Was I?
He was	he was not	He wasn't	Was he ?
She was	She was not	She wasn't	Was she ?
It was	It was not	It wasn't	Was it ?
We were	We were not	We weren't	Were we ?
You were	You were not	You weren't	Were you?
They were	They were not	They weren't	Were they?

*Examples:

1/Ten minutes ago the Captain and the Mate were on the bridge.

2/The Mate was angry because the two deck hands were not around.

3/It was midnight but I wasn't very sleepy.

4/Were you in the galley half an hour ago? No, was in my cabin.

5/Was the Captain angry about the mistake? Yes, he was very angry.
